 Fasten a pair of mount brackets and roller shafts using 2xM6 screws and washers Note these should be assembled as opposite pairs Only insert the screws 2-3 turns
 Place one bracket assembly over the dovetail. The pin should face inwards. Loosely tighten and slide against end cap
6. Slide the roller over the pin
 Slide the opposing bracket into the roller and over the dovetail Loosely tighten
 9. Centre the roller on the rack 10. Tighten M6 bolts to specified torque 11. Check roller spins freely Note: if roller is hard to turn, loosen bolts and make a small gap between the pin and end cap
