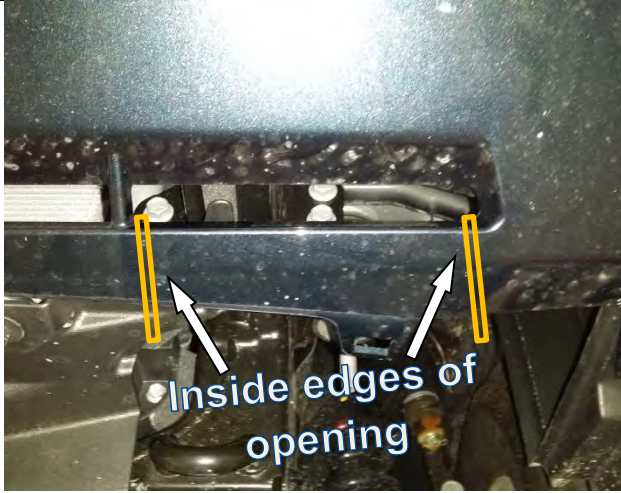

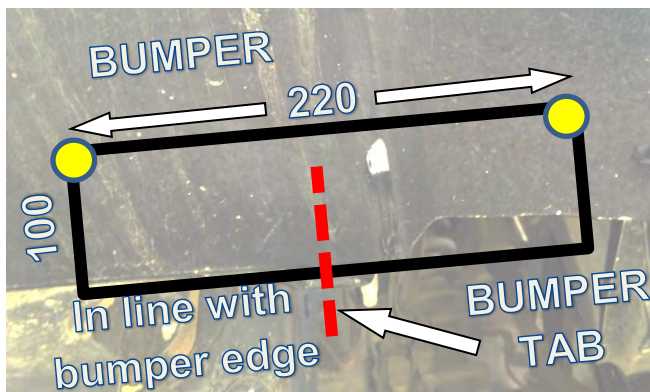

FITTING PROCEDURE FOR PRADO 150 (VEHICLE FITTED WITH FACTORY BUMPER)



Prado Oct '13 Onwards



Prado Pre MY13

1. Cut lower section of bumper as shown to allow for clearance to recovery point. Cut is only required for side in which recovery point is to be fitted. Use a jig saw to perform this task. It is advised to drill a hole in each corner for the Pre MY13 model bumper (using a 10mm drill bit) before cutting. This will allow the pinch weld to sit neater on the cut edges.
2. Position pinch weld supplied in kit around cut edges and discard any excess length.

Place a small amount of Sikaflex on cut edges before applying pinch weld.



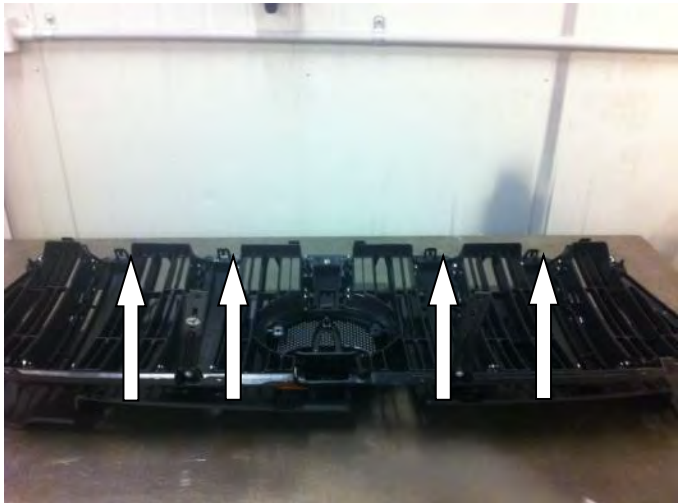

3. Remove radiator top cover by removing the plugs as shown. Retain for re-fitting.



4. Remove the four bolts which retain the top of the grille as shown. Retain for re-fitting.



5. Remove grille by releasing the lower tabs connected to the bumper shown.

VX and Kakadu only: Unplug the camera as the grille is removed.



6. Remove the screws securing the bumper to wheel arch area and across the lower section across the front so that there are no more fasteners securing the bumper.
7. Remove the lower joining panel from the bumper to the sump guard.
8. Work the inner guard liners away from the bumper and reaching in behind, undo the connections to the following if fitted: fog lamps, parking sensors (connection is on LHS of vehicle), headlamp washers (use a cable tie to crimp off the hose to prevent washer bottle leaking).



9. Carefully (ideally with the aid of another person) unclip each outer of the bumper at the guard as shown and remove bumper.



10. Remove impact beam at mounts to chassis by removing M10 bolts.
Retain bolts and impact beam for re-fitting.



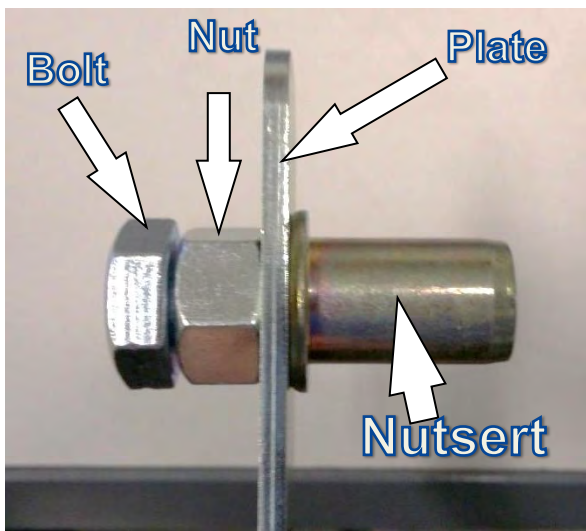
11. Loosen M12 nut from body mount bolt until it reaches near the edge of bolt thread (do not remove nut or bolt).

Only loosen side that the recovery point is being mounted to.



12. On some models the wheel arch splash guard may clip into a lower section of the chassis compared to others. You can check this by holding the recovery point up against the chassis (aligning the mounting holes) and checking if it interferes.

If this is the case, cut section of splash guard retaining clip as shown. Dispose of clip.



13. Assemble nutsert installation assembly as per image using an M12x1.75x40mm bolt, M12x1.75 nut, nutsert install plate and M12x1.75 nutsert.

Note: Add oil/lubricant to bolt thread in order to reduce the effort required to install nutsert in the next section.



14. Position nutsert install assembly end into chassis hole as shown.

15. Using 2 spanners, keep bolt head and nutsert install plate stationary and rotate nut anti-clockwise whilst ensuring that nutsert flange is flat against chassis and compresses to grip around hole.

16. Once properly installed, remove nut, bolt and nutsert install plate from assembly.

Discard of nut and nutsert install plate.

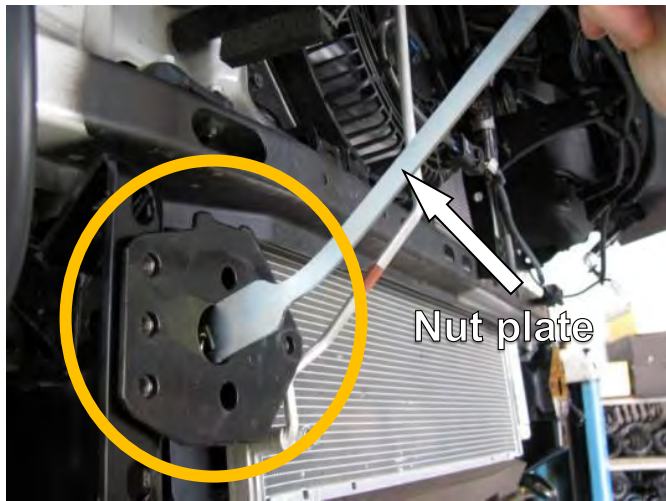
Retain bolt.



17. Loosely fasten recovery point to chassis using M8 x 1.25 x 90mm bolt, M8 x 26 x 2.8 washer (black), M12 x 1.25 x 90 bolt, 3x M12 washers and M12x1.75x40 bolt.

When requiring access to top M12 bolt for fastening recovery point to chassis, lift the body mount bolt out of the way.

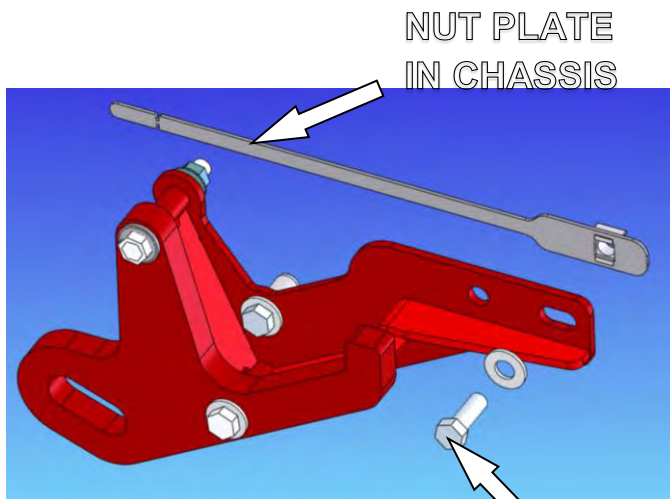
Position the third M12 washer mentioned between the recovery point and chassis at lower M12 bolt in order to even out the spacing introduced by the nutsert flange.

18. Insert M12 cage nut into nut plate extension and position nut plate into chassis opening at front.

Note that for recovery point being fitted to RHS, the nut plate extension will need to be bent up as shown. This is to clear the cross tube in the chassis.



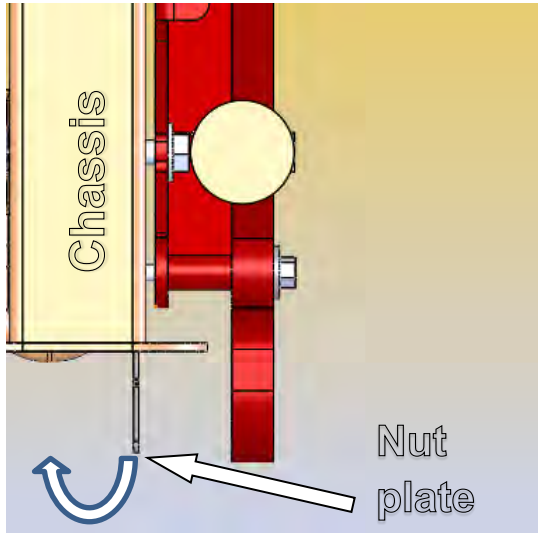

19. Position M12 x 1.75 x 35mm bolt and M12 washer in rear mounting hole as shown. Tighten to torque specification below.

20. Tighten the remaining fasteners joining recovery point to chassis.
21. Re-tighten body mount bolt.
22. Bend nut plate or break off end at notch if necessary so that it does not protrude from opening in the chassis when looking from the top.

23. Re-fit impact absorber and bumper in reverse order to removal.
24. Position warning label on the lower section of the bumper next to the cut-out performed in STEP 1.

FITTING PROCEDURE FOR FJ CRUISER (VEHICLE FITTED WITH FACTORY BUMPER)



1. Remove protective plate if fitted.



2. Remove plastic cover located under bumper from whichever side the recovery point is to be installed.



3. Remove front fasteners from stone tray. Retain fasteners for reuse.



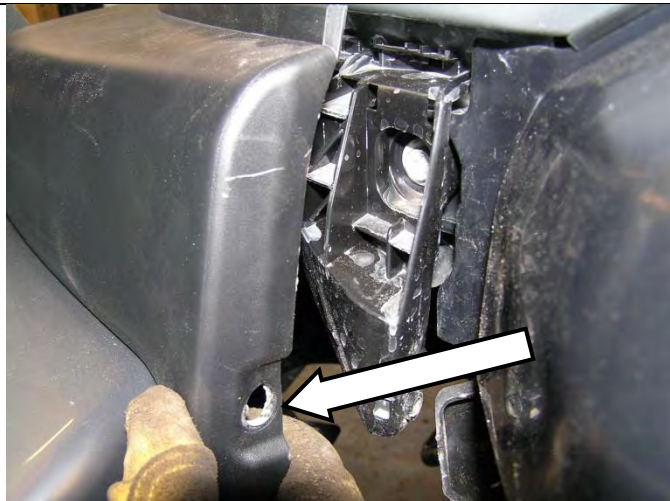
4. Remove screws in lower bumper and in wheel arch.



5. Remove grille. Screws are located in tabs at the top of the grille.
Release clips that are located on inside lower section.



6. Remove plastic rivets along top of bumper.



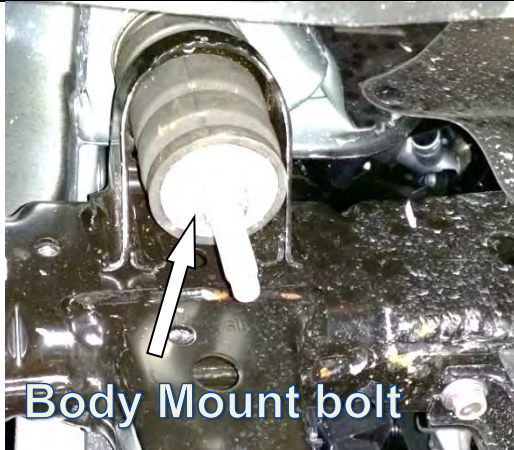
7. Remove screw then remove front bumper cover from vehicle.
Note: Prise the rear lip of the bumper off the retaining spigot where screw was located (as shown with arrow) then pull bar wing outward.



8. Remove front impact beam (8 flange nuts).
Retain impact beam and nuts for re-fitting.



- Fit an M12 cage nut into the nut plate extension.



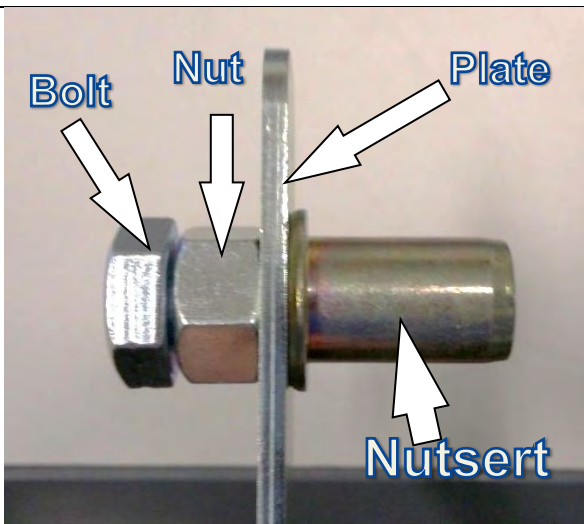
- Loosen nut from body mount bolt until it reaches near the edge of bolt thread (do not remove bolt).

Only loosen side that the recovery point is being mounted to.



- On some models the wheel arch splash guard may clip into a lower section of the chassis compared to others. You can check this by holding the recovery point up against the chassis (aligning the mounting holes) and checking if it interferes.

If this is the case, cut section of splash guard retaining clip as shown. Dispose of clip.



- Assemble nutsert installation assembly as per image using an M12x1.75x40mm bolt, M12x1.75 nut, nutsert install plate and M12x1.75 nutsert.

Note: Add oil/lubricant to bolt thread in order to reduce the effort required to install nutsert in the next section.



13. Position nutsert install assembly end into chassis hole as shown.
14. Using 2 spanners, keep bolt head and plate stationary and rotate nut anti-clockwise whilst ensuring that nutsert flange is flat against chassis and compresses to grip around hole.
15. Once nutsert is properly installed, remove nut, bolt and nutsert install plate from assembly.

Discard of nut and nutsert install plate and retain bolt.



16. Loosely fasten recovery point to chassis using M8 x 1.25 x 90mm bolt, M8 x 26 x 2.8 washer (black), M12 x 1.25 x 90 bolt, 3x M12 washers and M12x1.75x40 bolt.

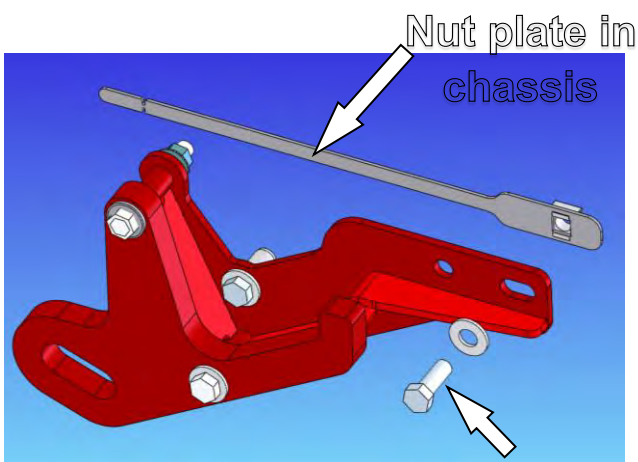
When requiring access to top M12 bolt for fastening recovery point to chassis, lift the body mount bolt out of the way.

Position the third M12 washer mentioned between the recovery point and chassis at lower M12 bolt in order to even out the spacing introduced by the nutsert flange.



17. Position nut plate into chassis opening at front.

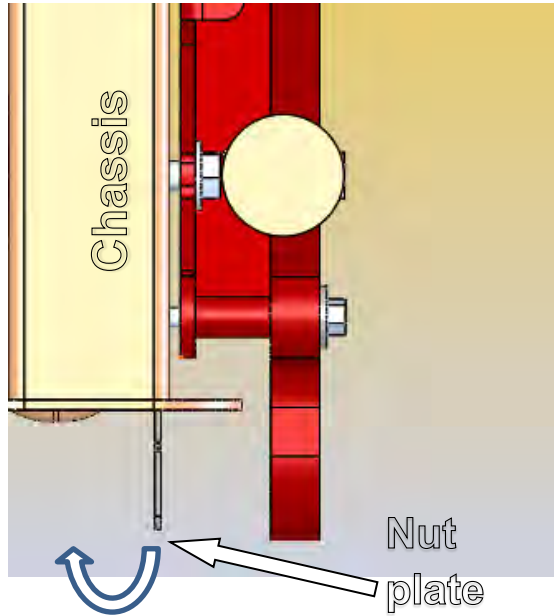

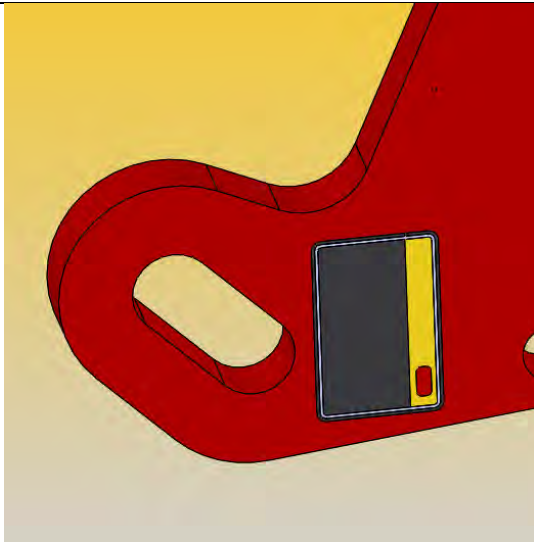

22. Re-fit impact absorber and bumper in reverse order to removal.
23. Position warning label on recovery point as shown.

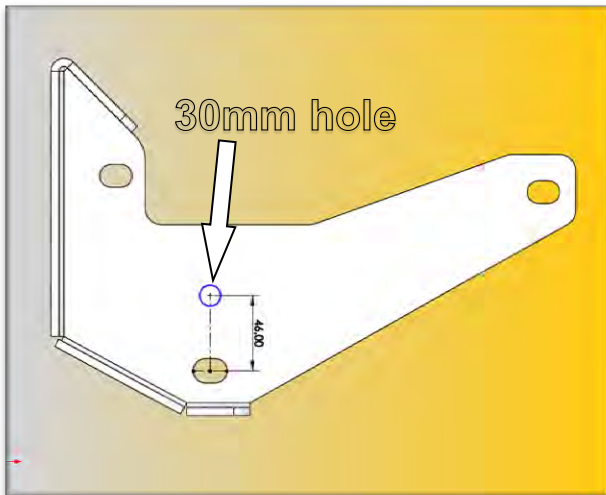
FITTING PROCEDURE FOR PRADO 150 (Fitted with an ARB bull bar)



1. Remove ARB bull bar along with ARB impact absorber, chassis mount bracket(s), braces and under-panels.

(Refer to ARB bull bar fitting instructions that came with the bull bar).

Note: Do not remove chassis mount bracket connected to chassis on the side you are not fitting a recovery point to.



2. Drill a 30mm hole at the position shown marked 46mm directly above existing mounting hole (LHS) or 40mm (RHS) on the chassis mount bracket removed in STEP 1.

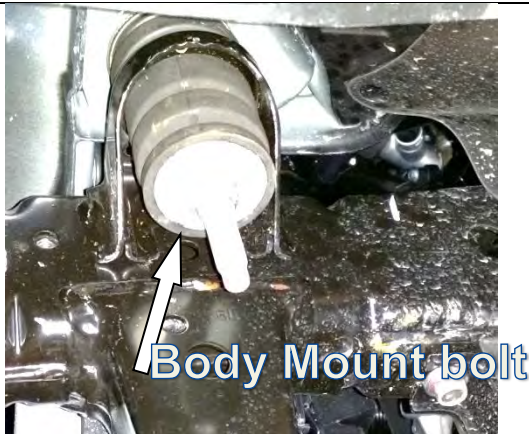
Apply black spray paint to cut edges of drilled hole.

Note: This is only required on the side the recovery point is being mounted to.



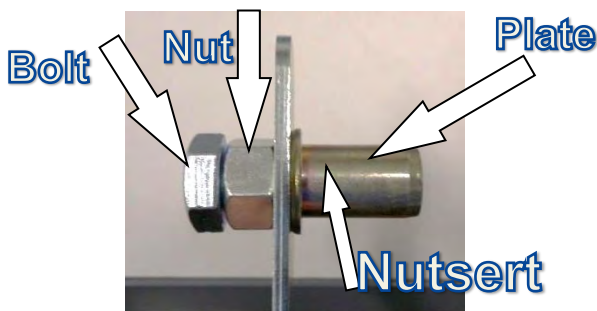
Warning: Drilling operations can result in flying metal debris, safety glasses should be worn.

Note: This step only applies if hole doesn't already exist in bracket.



3. Loosen nut from body mount bolt until it reaches near the edge of bolt thread (do not remove bolt).

Only loosen side that the recovery point is being mounted to.



4. Assemble nutsert installation assembly as per image using an M12x1.75x40mm bolt, M12x1.75 nut, nutsert install plate and M12x1.75 nutsert.

Note: Add oil/lubricant to bolt thread in order to reduce the effort required to install nutsert in the next section.



5. Position nutsert install assembly end into chassis hole as shown.
6. Using 2 spanners, keep bolt head and nutsert install plate stationary and rotate nut anti-clockwise whilst ensuring that nutsert flange is flat against chassis and compresses to grip around hole.
7. Once properly installed, remove nut, bolt and nutsert install plate from assembly.

Discard of nut and nutsert install plate.

Retain bolt.



8. Loosely fasten recovery point to chassis using M8 x 1.25 x 90mm bolt, M8 x 26 x 2.8 washer (black), M12 x 1.25 x 90 bolt, 3x M12 washers and M12x1.75x40 bolt.

When requiring access to top M12 bolt for fastening recovery point to chassis, lift the body mount bolt out of the way.

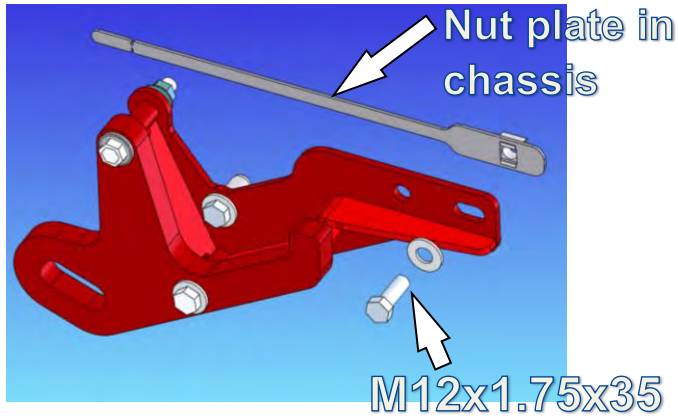
Position the third M12 washer mentioned between the recovery point and nutsert at top M12 bolt in order to even out the spacing introduced by the nutsert flange.

Note: Models fitted with bull bars where M8 captive nut in chassis is drilled out, use M12x1.25x90mm bolt with M12x1.25 flange nut in place (supplied).

9. Insert M12 cage nut into nut plate extension and position nut plate into chassis opening at front.
Note that for recovery point being fitted to RHS, the nut plate extension will need to be bent up as shown. This is to clear the cross tube in the chassis.

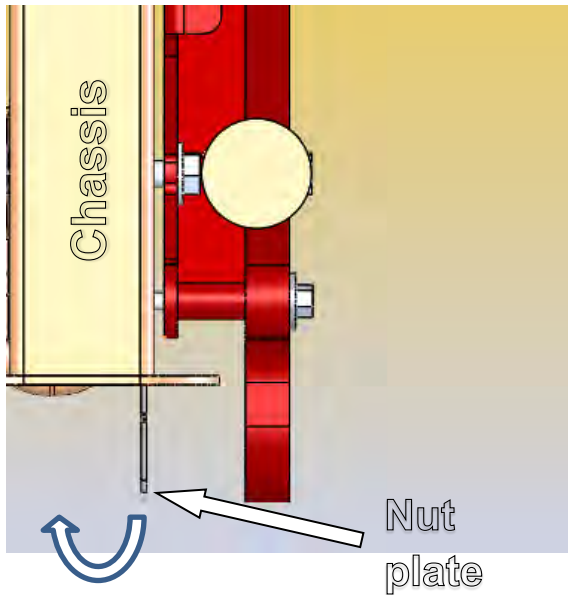


10. Position M12 x 1.75 x 35mm bolt and M12 washer at rear mounting hole as shown. Tighten.

13. Bend nut plate or break off end at notch if necessary so that it does not protrude from opening in chassis when looking from the top.

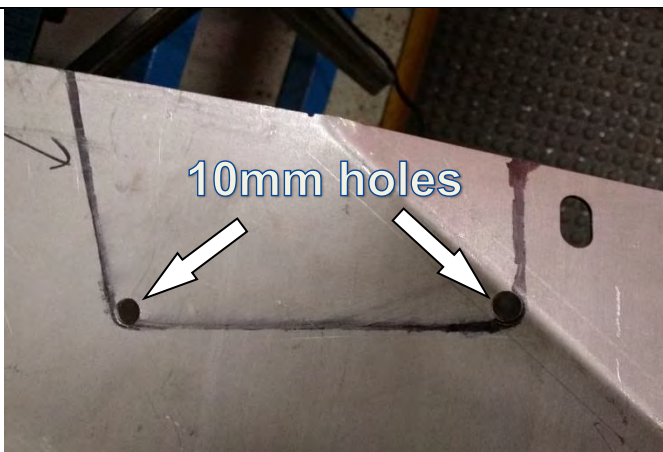

14. Cut-out wing under-panel template located at the end of these instructions which corresponds to the vehicle model the recovery is being fitted to.

15. Stick template onto loose wing under panel using masking tape or similar, on the side which the recovery point is being mounted to.

16. Mark inside edges of the template onto wing under-panel using a black marker and punch centre holes in corners using a hole punch.

17. Drill 2 x 10mm holes in the corners where punched using a drill and 10mm drill bit.

18. Using a jig-saw, cut around marked line of wing under-panel.

19. Clean up cut edges using a hand file.

20. Apply black spray paint to cut edges and let dry.



Warning: Drilling operations can result in flying metal debris, safety glasses should be worn.

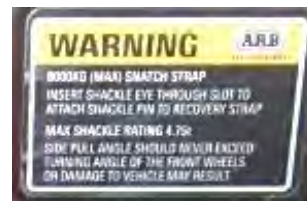


21. Apply small amount of Stikaflex to cut edges where the pinch weld is to be applied.
Apply pinch weld and cut off any excess length.

Note: Cut pinch weld off where it reaches bend.



22. Re-fit bull bar and associated components in reverse order to removal.
23. Position warning label on wing under-panel as shown.



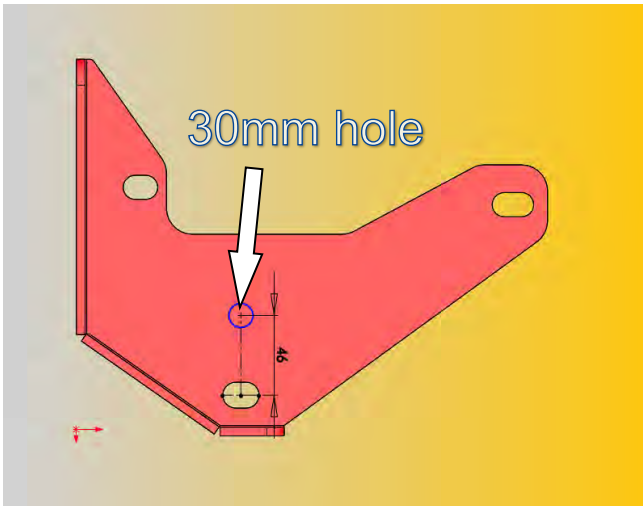
FITTING PROCEDURE FOR FJ CRUISER (Fitted with an ARB bull bar)



1. Remove ARB bull bar along with ARB impact absorber, chassis mount bracket(s), braces and under-panels.

(Refer to ARB bull bar fitting instructions that came with the bull bar).

Note: Do not remove chassis mount bracket connected to chassis on the side you are not fitting a recovery point to.



2. Drill a 30mm hole at the position shown marked 46mm directly above existing mounting hole (LHS) or 40mm (RHS) on the chassis mount bracket removed in STEP 1.

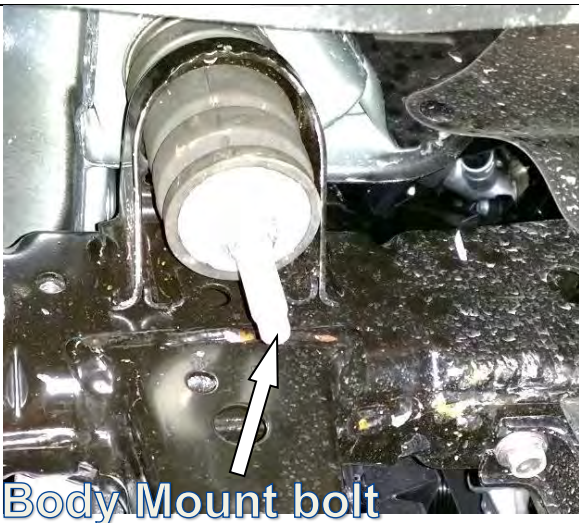
Apply black spray paint to cut edges of drilled hole.

Note: This is only required on the side the recovery point is being mounted to.



Note: This step only applies if hole doesn't already exist in bracket.

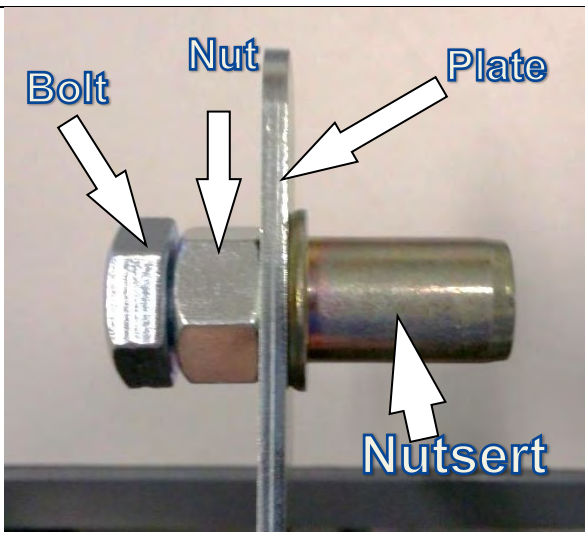

3. Loosen nut from body mount bolt until it reaches near the edge of bolt thread (do not remove bolt).

Only loosen side that the recovery point is being mounted to.



4. Assemble nutsert installation assembly as per image using an M12x1.75x40mm bolt, M12x1.75 nut, nutsert install plate and M12x1.75 nutsert.

Note: Add oil/lubricant to bolt thread in order to reduce the effort required to install nutsert in the next section.



5. Position nutsert install assembly end into chassis hole as shown.
6. Using 2 spanners, keep bolt head and nutsert install plate stationary and rotate nut anti-clockwise whilst ensuring that nutsert flange is flat against chassis and compresses to grip around hole.
7. Once properly installed, remove nut, bolt and nutsert install plate from assembly.

Discard of nut and nutsert install plate.

Retain bolt.

8. Loosely fasten recovery point to chassis using M8 x 1.25 x 90mm bolt, M8 x 26 x 2.8 washer (black), M12 x 1.25 x 90 bolt, 3x M12 washers and M12x1.75x40 bolt.

When requiring access to top M12 bolt for fastening recovery point to chassis, lift the body mount bolt out of the way.

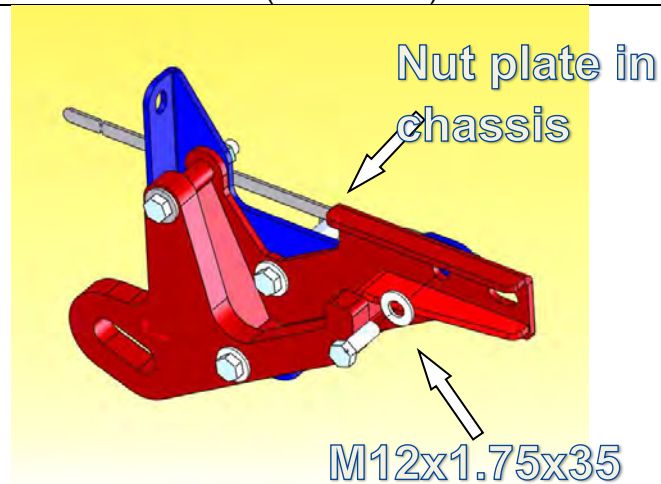
Position the third M12 washer mentioned between the recovery point and nutsert at top M12 bolt in order to even out the spacing introduced by the nutsert flange.



9. Fit M12 cage nut into nut plate and insert nut plate into chassis opening at front.

10. Position M12 x 1.25 x 35mm bolt and M12 washer at rear mounting hole as shown. Tighten.



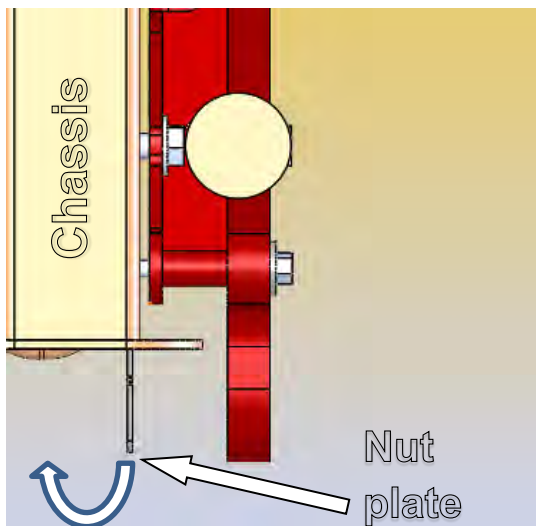

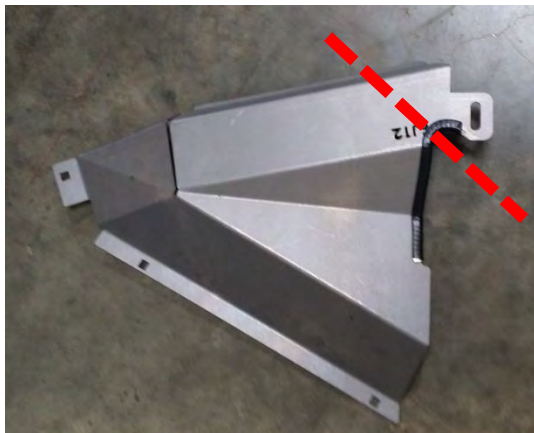

15. Stick template onto loose wing under panel using masking tape or similar, on the side which the recovery point is being mounted to.
16. Mark inside edges of the template onto wing under-panel using a black marker and punch centre holes in corners using a hole punch.
17. Using a jig-saw, cut around marked line of wing under-panel.
18. Clean up cut edges using a hand file.
19. Apply black spray paint to cut edges and let dry.

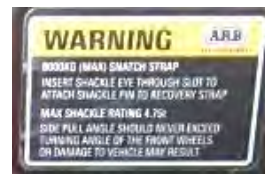


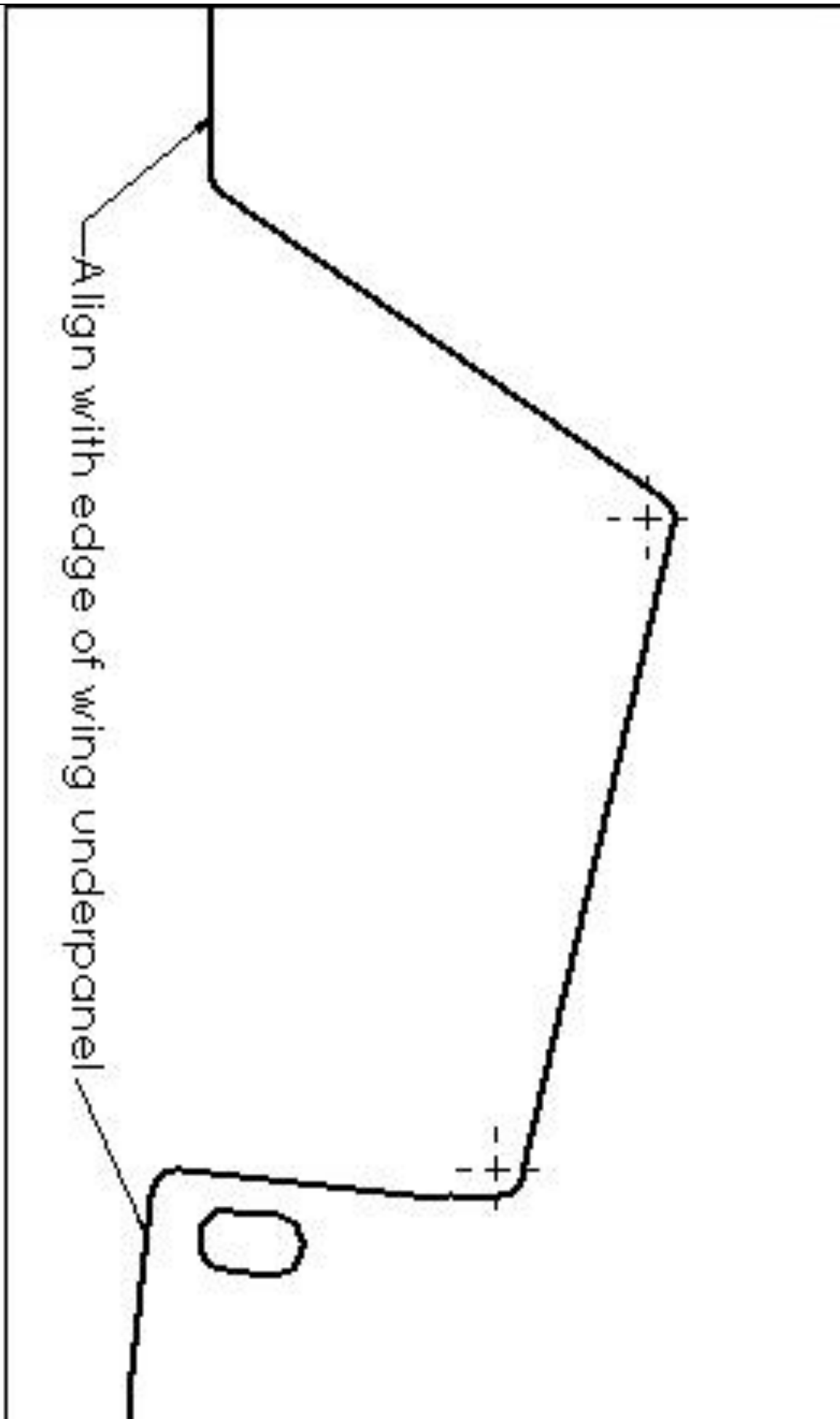

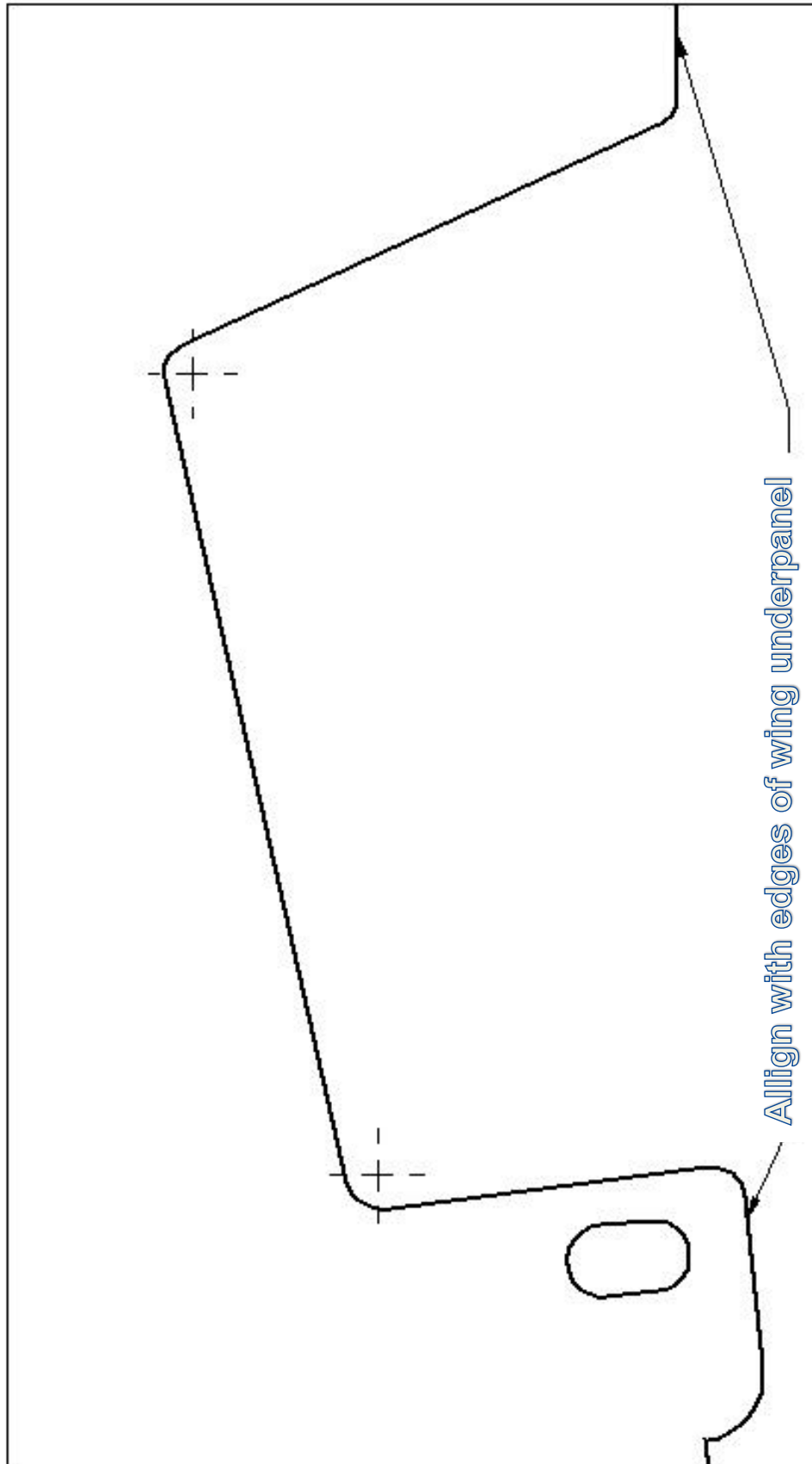
