



PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 1. Remove all electrical connections.
- 2. Remove the two upper bolts at the frame on each side. See Figure 1
- 3. Remove the rear bumper.





5. **If sensors are equipped:** Install parking sensors by inserting into the holes on bumper and pressing with sensor L-tabs against bumper plate. Fasten L-tabs with the supplied M6 hardware (14-17). **See Figure 2-3**. Use supplied double sided tape between sensor and L-Tab to keep the sensor from rotating.

If sensors are not equipped: Place the supplied plugs in the sensor holes.

- 6. Use zip ties to secure sensor in place.
 - *Note*: Be sure to maintain the orientation of the sensor so that it remains consistent with its original orientation.
- 7. Tighten M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs.











8. Using the supplied M12 hardware and factory hardware, loosely assemble the mounting brackets to the frame. See Figure 5-6






9. Insert the supplied M12 bolt plates into the bumper. See Figure 6.



10. With help, loosely assemble the bumper to the mounting brackets. See Figure 7.




11. Install the Trailer plug and license plate at this time.

WARNING.

After you have mounted bumper on main brackets. CAREFULLY open tailgate. While tailgate is open, adjust the height of the bumper so that it has at least 3/8" of clearance with respect to the tailgate. Torque to 50-55 ft-lbs.


LIGHT INSTALLATION

- 1. Disconnect the battery from your vehicle.
- 2. Locate the license plate lights (pre-installed) in the bumper. Pop out the lights by squeezing the clips in on the backside. **See Figure 8.**
- 3. Locate the factory wiring for the license plate lights. Strip back the wiring on the factory harness and supplied light. Using connectors, crimp the red wire on the positive factory wire and the black wire to the factory ground wire. **See Figure 9**








4. Push the light back in until it clips into place. Repeat on the opposite side. See Figure 10



- 5. Remove the light from the rubber grommet. Install the rubber grommet into the back up light location on the bumper. Then, reinstall the light into the rubber grommet. See Figure 11-12
- 6. Looking at the backside of the lower reverse lights, there are three wires: a ground wire, optional (off road only) tail light wire, and a reverse light (bright) wire. Using the figure below, connect the reverse light wire to the factory reverse light harness, and ground wire to a factory ground wire. If using the optional tail light wire, connect the Tail light wire to a switch. See Figure 12
- 7. Reconnect your battery.




